- Jamie Moore – Swimming – Honey baked Ham fundraiser, received lap clock – Boosters helped pay for 50% at \$500 – they used for the 1st time today, Jan. 19th – Soap meet with Brunswick
- Nick Kaplack – Baseball - lifting/conditioning program started (about 50 athletes involved), Field renovations make Medina field best in conference. Funds for field renovation and batting cage almost all came from private donation. Asks for a couple needs: 1) help finding someone to install turf – Bill Mc Millen will follow up with Nick on this. 2) Would like Boosters to purchase a windscreen with the RS logo. Nick will get price on windscreen and submit to Bill McMillen – if within his approval range then he will approve otherwise will need to be a vote. Fundraisers: Spaghetti dinner fundraiser in March.
